



PROJECT SUMMARY

This project involved the concurrent interior demolition of 400,000 square feet of finishes across three buildings undergoing fast-track renovations for one of the world’s largest technology companies. Bayview Demolition (formerly Demo Masters) was tasked with achieving a 95% reuse and recycling rate while executing the work on an accelerated schedule.

Materials diverted from landfills and recycled or repurposed included 400,000 square feet of ceiling tile, 200,000 square feet of carpet tile, 2,000 tons of metal, and hundreds of doors, windows, casework components, and fixtures. Bayview worked closely with the general contractor to respond swiftly to design changes and coordinated with reuse specialists to ensure materials were recovered as requested—enabling the owner to pursue LEED Gold/Platinum certification for the renovation.
